ORDER

WHEREAS the West Bengal Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as the 'State Board'), is executing different provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for prevention and control of pollution in the state of West Bengal.

AND WHEREAS as per the provisions of section 23 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 24 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, any person empowered by the State Board has the right to enter and inspect for the purpose of examining and testing any industrial plant, record, register, documents or any other material object, any control equipment.

AND WHEREAS the Government of India, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industries, has laid emphasis on "Ease of Doing Business" for providing efficient, convenient, transparent and integrated electronic services to the applicants. Under the "Ease of Doing Business" emphasis is on self-regulation and self-reporting by the industries. As On-line monitoring system is being implemented by 17 category industries, CETPs and CBMWTFs and the data can be accessed from the central servers of the State Board, hence, instead of frequent inspections, the inspections should be for surveillance and vigilance on a random basis.

AND WHEREAS on the basis of concurrence by the Government of West Bengal, the Department of Environment and the State Board, **Online Consent Management** was adopted and implemented within the state of West Bengal with effect from **01.06.2015** by the State Board.

NOW THEREFORE to streamline and develop standard operating procedure for inspections, the State Board hereby adopts the following :

1. Reasonable number of Inspections of industries to be conducted for maintaining surveillance and vigilance on a random basis based on pollution potential of the industries after serving due notice as prescribed in rule 3 of Notification No. Env/460/2R-4/82 dated 12.5.1993.
2. Green category of industries having minimum pollution potential need not require any environmental inspection unless any specific order or direction or requirement arises.
3. Inspection report shall be prepared by the inspecting official(s) as per **Annexure A** and submitted to the next higher authority within 72 working hours of conducting inspection.

The existing protocol of inspection of seriously / grossly polluting industries as currently followed by the Board, shall however continue. This order will take immediate effect.
